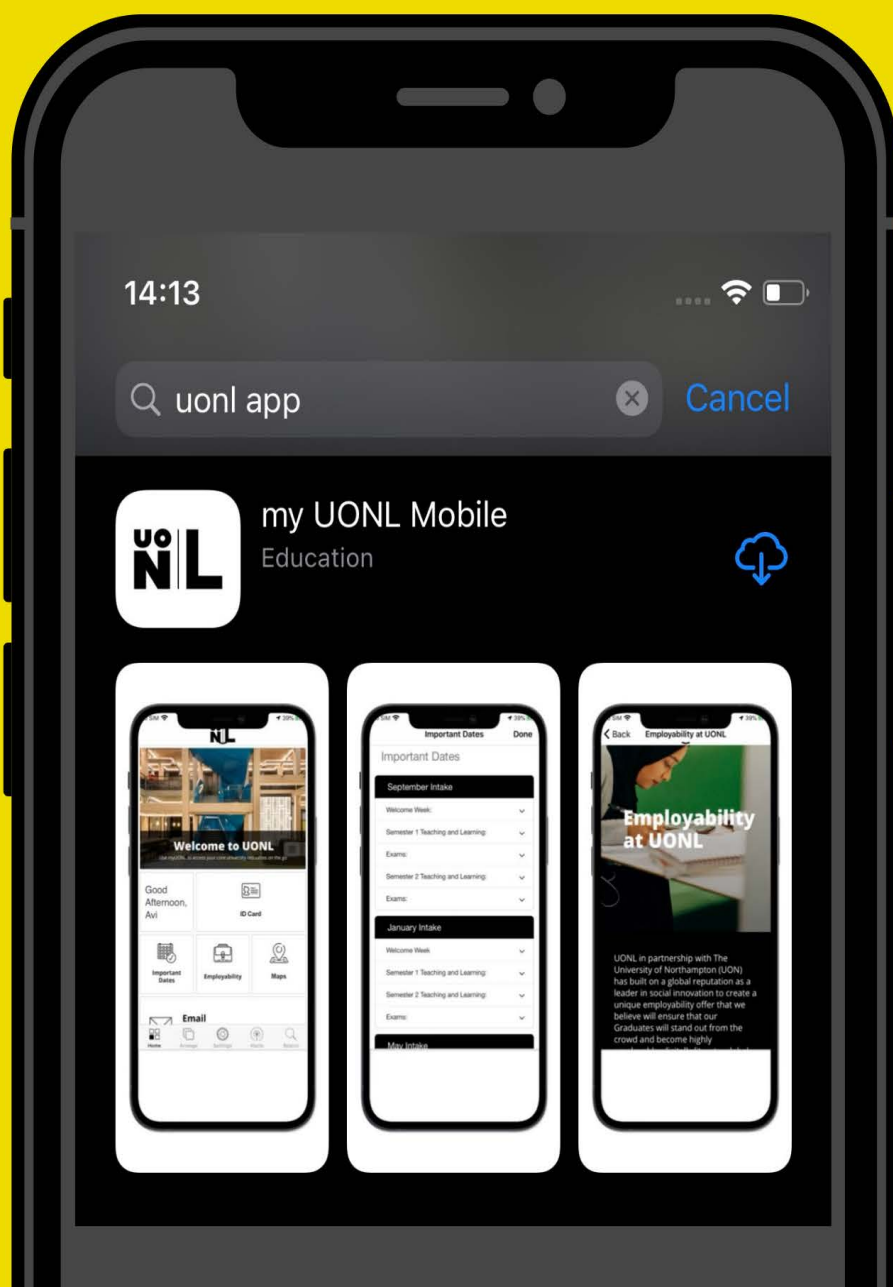


How to Download the App

The app is available on both Android and iOS through play store and app store, respectively. Just search 'myUONL' in the search bar and click the install button.



Logging in

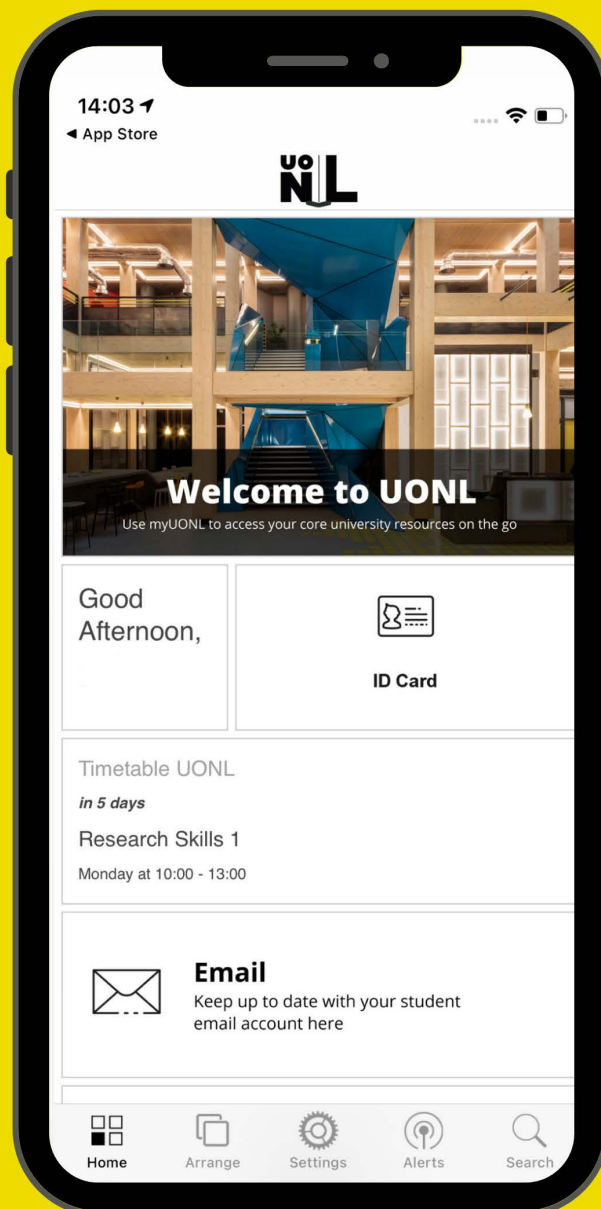
Your login details for the myUONL app is the exact same as your VLE log in. Your username will be your UONL Student ID (7XXXXX) and your Password will be your date of birth in 6-digit format (unless you have changed this).

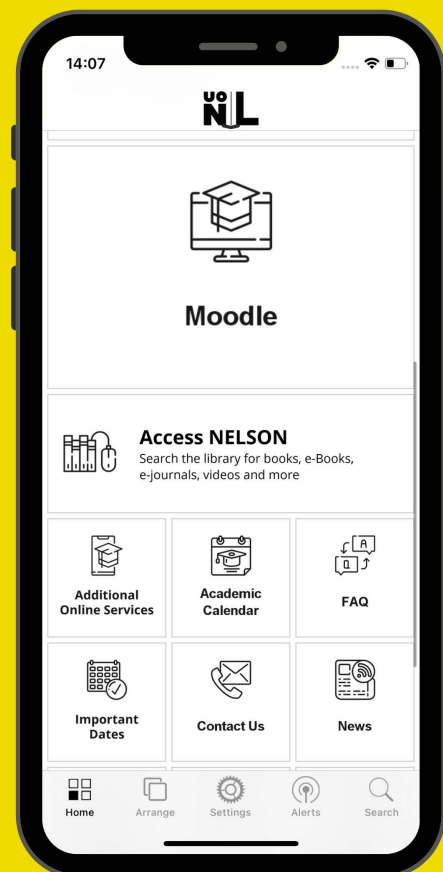
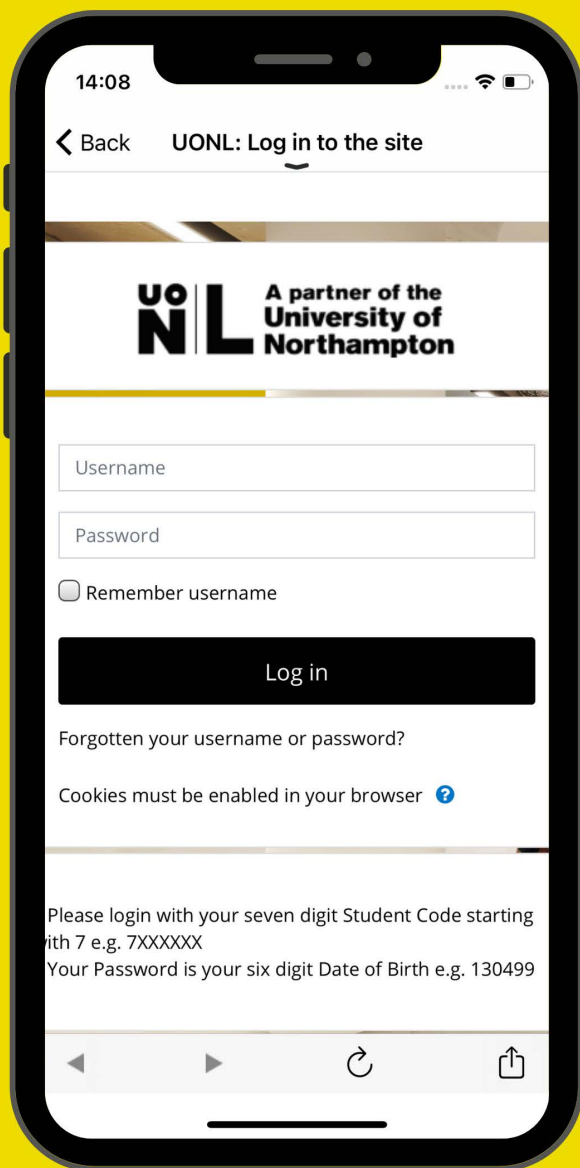
Using the App

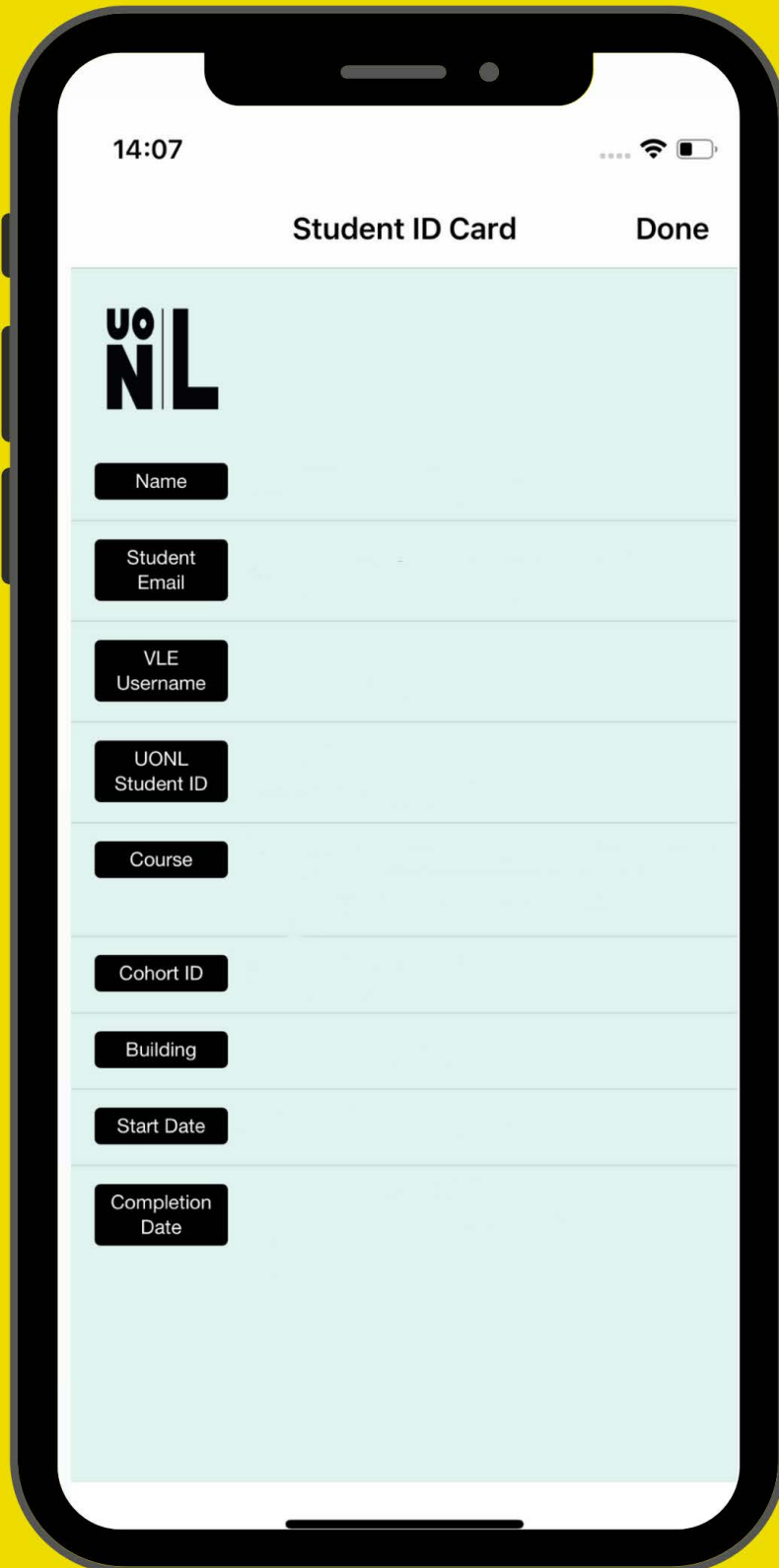
VLE

Your digital Student ID Card is available here on myUONL App.



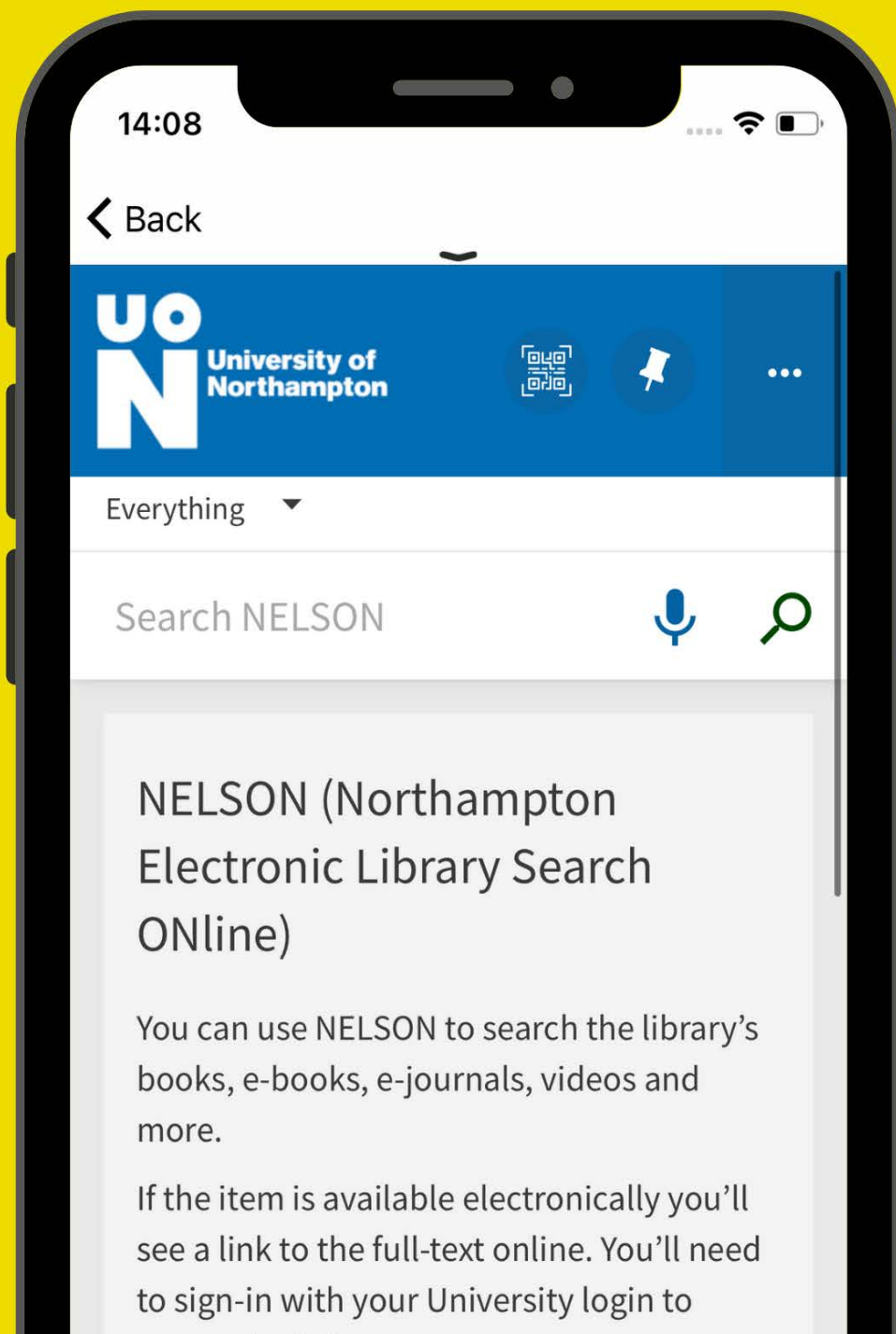
Timetable

You can see the schedule of your assigned modules in Timetable.



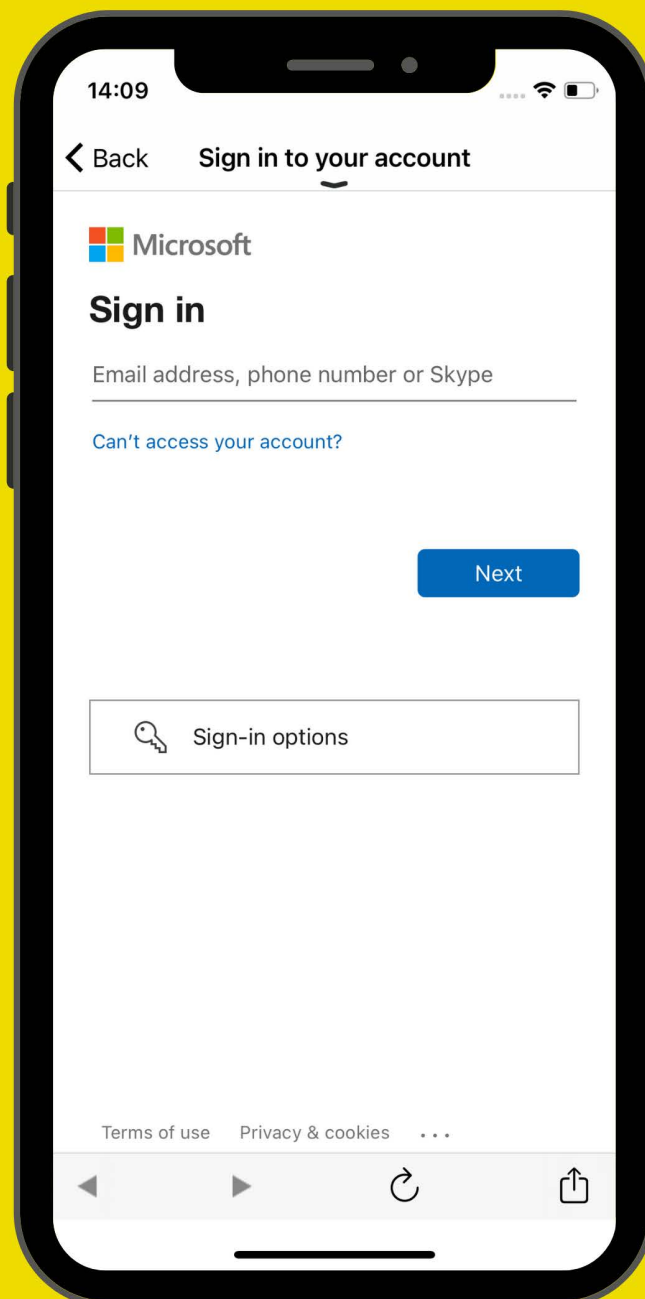
Digital Library
