Self-Funding Tuition Fees

Will you be self-funding your tuition fees?
What you need to know.

If you will be self-funding your tuition fees, there are some key dates and T&Cs which you need to know.

Tuition fee cost

If you are starting in **September 2022** the tuition fee for an Undergraduate degree is £9,250 per academic year.

Payment plan

Throughout the academic year (September 2022 to May 2023) you will have to pay the full year's tuition fee. The payment deadlines split the tuition fee into three instalments (£3,085.00, £3085.00 and £3085.00). Tuition fee payment deadlines for academic year 2021/22 are:

First Instalment: 26th September 2022 (£3,085.00)

Second Instalment: 16th January 2023 (£3,085.00)

Third Instalment: 17th April 2023 (£3080.00)

Failure to meet payment deadlines

If you have been identified as a self-funding student and have received a statement of account which will include the payment deadlines mentioned above, you must adhere to the payment deadlines. If you fail to meet the deadline a member of the UONL Finance Department will get in touch and, if no payment is made within 48 hours, you will be withdrawn from the course. Under no circumstances will there be any deviation from this.

Making a payment

Payments can be made via bank transfer or using the e-payment facility.

Withdrawing from your course

If at any time you withdraw from your course or decide to leave UONL under no circumstances will a refund of your tuition fee be paid. If you decide to intermit or defer your entry no refund will be paid and the full tuition fee for that academic year will be due when you recommence your studies.

Withdrawal tuition fee liability

The amount of tuition fee owed will depend on when the official withdrawal date from UONL was processed. Any student who withdraws on or before 16th January 2023 will be liable to 25% of the tuition fee for that academic year. If a withdrawal is processed on or after 17th January 2022 the student will be liable to pay 50% of the tuition fee for that academic year. If a student withdraws after 17th April 2022, the student will be liable to pay 100%.
